This page describes how to manage the site in relation to the processing of personal data of users who use it.

The information is provided only for that site and not to other Web sites accessed via links.

## **PLACE OF DATA PROCESSING**

Treatment related to the services on this web site are at the above premises and are only handled by staff processing.

No data from the web service is communicated or disseminated.

Personal data provided by users who request dispatch of informative material is used only to perform the service or provision requested and not disclosed to third parties unless such disclosure is required by law or is strictly necessary for the fulfillment of user requests.

## **TYPES OF DATA**

- Navigation data

Computer systems and software used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the communication protocols of the Internet.

This information is not collected for association to specific individuals, but by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, to identify users.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users connecting

to the site, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in reply, the numerical code indicating the status of response from the server (successful, error, etc..) and other parameters regarding the operating system and computer environment.

These data are used only to obtain anonymous statistical information about the site and to check its correct functioning and is deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site except for this possibility, the data on web contacts for more than seven days.

- Data provided voluntarily by user

The optional, explicit and voluntary e-mail addresses listed on this site involves the acquisition of the sender, necessary to respond to requests, and other personal data included in the message.

Specific summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on web pages dedicated to particular services on request.

## **COOKIES**

No personal user data is acquired from the site.

We do not use cookies to transmit personal information, nor are used persistent cookies of any kind, or systems for tracking users.

The use of session cookies (which are not permanently stored on your computer and disappear when the browser is closed) is strictly limited to transmitting session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) necessary to enable a safe and efficient site.

The Session cookies are used on this site avoid the use of other techniques that could potentially compromise the privacy of the users and not allow the acquisition of personal identification data.

## **POSSIBILITY OF DATA**

Apart from that specified for navigation data, the user is free to provide personal data contained in the application forms or indicated in contacts with the office to request information material or other communications.

Their absence may make it impossible to fulfill the request.

## **METHOD OF TREATMENT**

Personal data are processed by automated tools for the time necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected.

Specific security measures are taken to prevent data loss, misuse or improper and unauthorized access.

## **USERS' RIGHTS**

The subjects whose personal data have the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence of such data and to know the content and origin, verify its accuracy or request its integration or updating, or correction (art. 7 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003).

Pursuant to this Article shall have the right to request cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or block of data in violation of the law, and oppose any case, for legitimate reasons, their treatment.
